It is essential that we are informed now of any special educational need or disability for which the School may be asked to make reasonable adjustments.

The initial assessment (Round I) involves a test carried out using a computer screen and a mouse lasting approximately 60 minutes. A boy's verbal and non-verbal reasoning is assessed alongside his numeric skills and linguistic dexterity. There is also an interview, lasting approximately 15 minutes, with an Eton Master (teacher). Neither of these components can be prepared for. Boys who are shortlisted will be called back to take part in the Scholarship examinations (Round II). This involves a three-day, two-night stay at the School. Boys will sit written papers (based on the National Curriculum) and be interviewed by Masters in three key subjects: English, Mathematics and Science. In addition, there will be a general academic interview and interviews with the Head Master and members of the academic and administrative staff.

Application forms, accompanied by a copy of the Birth Certificate (or satisfactory evidence of candidate's birth), plus a colour, passport-size photograph, should be sent to The Access Adviser, Eton College, Windsor, Berkshire SL4 6DB.
