If it is, then the second choice school should not make an offer. If the first choice school is not going to make an offer, then the second choice school is able to make an offer if they wish. An identical procedure follows for the school of third choice.
- •Awards accepted verbally must be confirmed in writing and must be taken up in the following academic year.
