

## **Assessment and Bursary Timeline for Applications**

Year	Deadline		
5	1 <sup>st</sup> May	Deadline for returning Details Update Form (only for boys registered before date in March). Without this, we will assume you do not wish to continue with the process and we will withdraw him.	
5	June	Eton will email boys' schools with details about the ISEB (Independent School Examination Board) Common Pre-Tests and how to register as an invigilation centre	
Summer after Year 5	End of July		Deadline for returning the Financial Aid Request Form to indicate that you would require a means-tested bursary should your son be awarded a place. Late Financial Aid Request Forms will not be accepted. You will then receive a Link to the online Bursaries Management System with instructions on how to submit your Bursary Application Form.
Summer after Year 5	August	Parents will receive further information regarding Stage 1 assessment, including how to register with the ISEB for the Common Pre-Tests (please do not register him before August). It is the parents' responsibility to liaise with your son's school to ask if they are willing to host the tests. If not, you will need to find an alternative venue.	
6	September	Eton will email boys' schools requesting a reference and reminding them to register as an invigilation centre (unless they have stated they are unable to host the tests).

6	15 <sup>th</sup> September		Bursary Application Forms must be submitted online. Late applications will not be accepted.
6	2 <sup>nd</sup> October to 30th November	Boys sit ISEB Common Pre- Tests anytime during this period, usually at their school. If not, they can sit them at Eton (dates tbc) or at an overseas test centre.	
6	31 <sup>st</sup> October	Deadline for schools to send reference.	
6	December	Results of Stage 1 assessment are emailed to parents and schools. Stage 2 will take place between January - May 2024 (details to follow in results email).	
6	February	Conditional offers will be made for boys who, on initial assessment by the Fees and Bursaries Team need significant bursaries of 80% or more (the early tranche).	Boys who, on initial assessment by the Fees and Bursaries Team need significant bursaries of 80% or more will be discussed by the Bursaries Committee to determine the level of financial assistance required.
6	March/ May/June	Conditional offers will be made for other tranches, 1, 2 and 3 according to when their birthday falls in the school year.	Boys who, on initial assessment by the Fees and Bursaries Team need bursary awards under 80% will be discussed by the Bursaries Committee to determine the level of financial assistance required
7		Admissions contact parents to allocate a House for boys with a conditional offer through the normal entry route.	
8	5 <sup>th</sup> September		All boys who have conditional offers of a place for the following September and who have bursary awards already in place will need to submit their updated financial details so that the award can be reassessed. This applies whether or not an application for a King's or Music Scholarship will be made.
8	31st October		Boys who <b>do not</b> have a conditional place at the School can submit a bursary application form as a non- registered candidate for a Music Scholarship (MS). Parents must submit a completed Means-Tested Financial Aid Request Form to start the process
